

ACCOMMODATION Campus Køge

Like most other educational institutions in Denmark, Zealand Institute of Business and Technology has no accommodation facilities on campus and even though we will help as much as possible, students must in principle make their own arrangements. Don't expect to find accommodation on short notice but make sure to start looking for accommodation well in advance.

There are a number of student halls of residence, both in the Køge area and in neighbouring areas/cities. International students are eligible for rooms on equal terms with Danish students, and it is possible to register on a waiting list via one or more of the websites below. *Please note that student rooms in Denmark are usually not furnished.* Many students live in private or rented rooms or flats (often sharing with other students) or rented rooms in residence halls.
